Description of Volunteer Positions

Team Parent: the Team Parent is also the Merchandise Coordinator and would be responsible for handling orders & money for Morris Rugby gear beyond the player's uniform. This includes items like sweatshirts, jackets, beanies, & blankets. Besides keeping track of orders and money the Team Parent/merchandise coordinator would also hand out the gear when it arrives. Money is forwarded on to the Morris Rugby Exec Administrator, Val Gibson. The Team Parent would also be responsible for organizing the end-of year party including finding a host location, lining up who is bringing food & beverages, paper products, etc. The Team Parent is not responsible for deciding the date of the party as that will be handled by Pam i/c/w the players' availability.

Treasurer: this person would be responsible for being available at the beginning of many practices and games in order to collect registration forms and checks. Forms would be given to Pam and checks would be forwarded on a regular basis to Val Gibson.

Social Coordinator: this person is responsible for organizing the food and beverages for any home game post-match socials as well as seeing that it is all set-up by the time the game is over and that everything is cleaned up afterwards. In the past 1 person handled this work. Going forward this should really be handled by all the parents on a rotating basis with the Coordinator responsible for scheduling who is working at which game, etc.

Fundraising Coordinator: this person would be responsible for working with the girls to help find fundraising opportunities, help establish dates for the fundraising activities and to provide an adult voice behind the girls when they speak to potential fundraising activity sponsors, e.g. supermarket managers for bake sales, gas stations owners for car-washes, etc. In general this person would oversee the girls' fundraising work to make sure that they are organized properly and that adult supervision is available at any events.

Team Photographer: This doesn't have to be just one person. The person or persons need to be at all games (that's why having more than 1 is helpful so there's someone available) and be able to take action shots during the game as well as candid before and after, plus team photos. If there was someone with a video camera, too, that would be great and wouldn't be needed all the time!

Sponsorship Coordinator: this person would work with other parents to gather a list of potential sponsors, including those who have sponsored the team in the past, and coordinating communication with them as well as with new potential sponsors, following up on sponsorship leads, sending out acknowledgement letters to actual sponsors and forwarding sponsorship money to Val Gibson.

Publicity: this person would be responsible for getting news article to all area papers as well as researching other ways of getting our team known in the metropolitan NJ-NY area. Ideally this position also works in the Fall as we being our recruiting drive in mid-October for the upcoming season. Again, this doesn't have to be one person doing the work but there needs to be someone responsible for seeing that the work gets done.
